What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the InvestNow Antipodes Global Fund - Long has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Implemented Investment Solutions Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

Objective: aims to achieve absolute returns in excess of the MSCI All Country World Net Index in NZ dollars over the investment cycle (typically 3-5 years).

Strategy: provides exposure to a diversified portfolio of international shares which is actively managed.

Example of how this applies to an investor

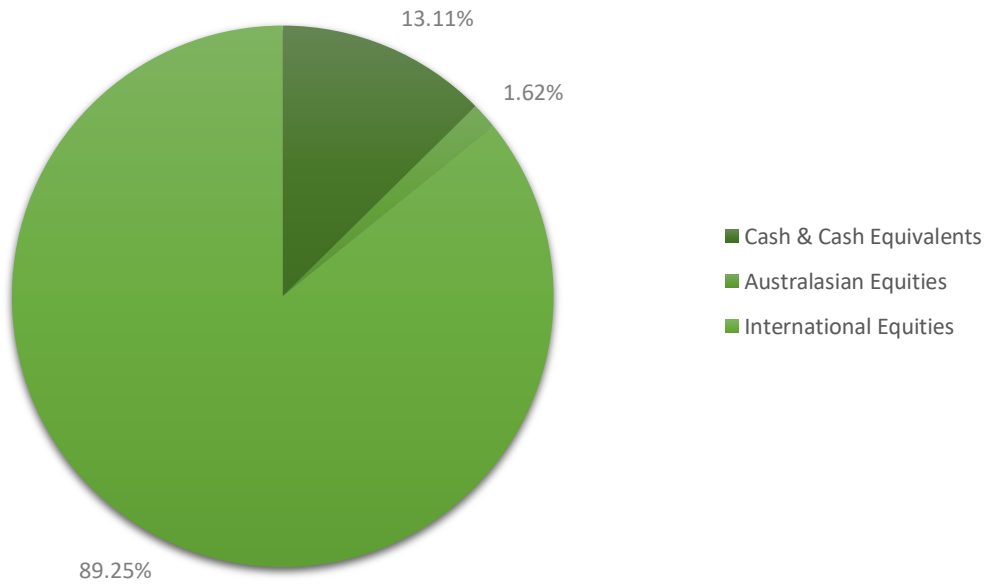
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund when the fund received its first contribution, on 18 November 2021, and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the period, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$20 (that is 0.20% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total return after tax of \$12 for the period.

What does the fund invest in?

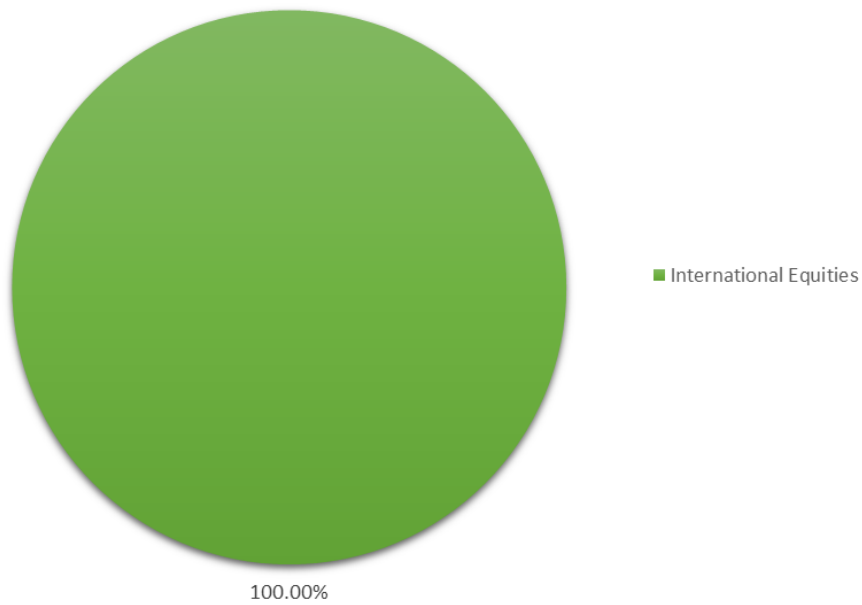
This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.

Notes
