What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the InvestNow Foundation Series High Growth Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. FundRock NZ Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

Objective: aims to provide returns that are broadly in line with the return of the underlying fund's investment benchmark before fees and tax over the long-term.

Strategy: provides exposure to a diversified fund that invests in a portfolio of predominantly growth assets but with a small amount of income asset exposure. The underlying fund incorporates certain responsible investment considerations and is exposed to investment strategies that seek to limit exposure to companies involved in specific business practices.

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.


Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund on the first day of the month following the fund's receipt of its first contribution, 1 August 2025 and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the period to 30 September 2025, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$634 (that is 6.34% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total return after tax of \$605 for the period.

This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.


Actual Investment Mix

Notes

- i. A combination of actual fund returns and market index returns have been used to determine the risk indicator as the fund has not been operating for the required five years. The risk indicator may therefore provide a less reliable indicator of the fund's future volatility. Market index returns have been used until July 2025 and fund returns thereafter.
- ii. As the InvestNow Foundation Series High Growth Fund only started accepting contributions on 3 July 2025 historical fee information is not available. The fund charges represent our best estimates of the fees and expenses that will be charged to the fund. These have been estimated using information provided by the underlying fund manager and by reference to the underlying fund's disclosure documents.
- iii. The top 10 assets add up to more than 100% of NAV as the fund also has liabilities which offsets these assets.
